What are a Compensation Health and Welfare Officer?

A Compensation Health & Welfare Officer represents members during a claims process, from filing of the claim through to the appeals tribunal stage if required. A CHWO works with its members on processes and measures to mitigate occurrences of injuries and occupational diseases.

A CHWO will also facilitate return to work (RTW) and labour market re entry (LMR) processes. With the new WSIB changes recently adopted, there will be more interaction needed with case managers, occupational nurses and HR than ever before in regards to LMR and RTW assessments.
